

Syllabus: “Introduction to German Studies”

International School, Summer Term 2024

(a) Inhalt und Ansatz | Content and Approach

- The target group consists of students who have not been studying in Germany before and are not yet familiar with living and/or studying in Germany. The course aims at introducing to pretended basics of “German” culture. The course uses Geert Hofstede’s six-dimension model of (national) culture and Alexander Thomas’ cultural standard model as frameworks for further investigation. Special emphasis lies on academic reflection and criticism towards Hofstede’s and Thomas’ models.
- Being designed as an academic introduction, the course work includes demanding academic reading, group work, research tasks and the submission of little projects. The course will be taught “blended”, combining on-site and online sessions.
- Students require at least an advanced level of English to follow the lessons.
- For the successful completion of the course, the student will be awarded 3 ECTS. Therefore, students should be prepared to spend considerable time working with the study content.
