

## Course Description – Winter Semester 2023/2024

<b>Content</b>	<p>During the first 45 minutes of each lesson an episode of an American or British television series (TV-shows) (or an excerpt of a movie) will be shown to the students. The episode contains different cases, e.g. as parts of a trial or other scenes with legal relevance. The selection of the episodes is made by the teachers; the cases must have business law reference. Each student has to watch one episode to be discussed in class one week before and has to prepare a legal analysis of the case. The student is asked to analyse the legal content of the episode, compare it with German law (or his national law) and present the results of his or her analysis to the other students. Afterwards, the group will discuss how to solve the case according to German law; the student “in charge” will have to chair the discussion.</p>
